

Summary Friday Sermon 14 May 2021

Delivered by Hazrat Khalifatul Masih Al-Khamis (a.b.a.)

After Tashahhud, Ta'awwaz and the recitation of Surah Al-Fatehah, Huzur-e-Anwar said:

The last few days, there was a non-Ahamadi religious scholar who had been frequently writing on social media platforms. He writes that wherever there is mischief in the world, the cause for it is always the Ahmadi people, to the extent that the issue of Palestine is also the fault of Ahmadis. This was his way of spreading hatred against Ahmadis. This is a common method for such people to spread hatred against us Ahmadis. We thank Allah Almighty that we have accepted the Promised Messiah and Mahdi who has taught us, that when you listen to such things, our job is always to pray and show patience.

Hazrat Masih-e-Maoud (as) has said that you should even pray for your enemies. This opposition is nothing new. The Promised Messiah (as) had people attacking him in a similar way. These opponents would even attack those who attended the sittings of the Promised Messiah (as) to listen to him. These non-Ahmadi religious scholars actually wanted to prevent these people from going towards the Promised Messiah (as) because they knew that once they heard what he had to say, heard his message of truth, they would accept him.

Our job is to keep praying. Finally, it will be some amongst these people who would accept Ahamdiyyat and show love towards Ahmadiyyat. Thus we should pray that may Allah release them of any problems and pains and may He guide us towards the right path.

Hazrat Musleh Maoud (ra) has explained certain events of opposition in the life of Hazrat Masih-e-Maoud (as). He said, "I myself witnessed in Lahore, people swearing at Hazrat Masih-e-Maoud (as). I was very young then and I would not understand why these people were doing so". Similarly an event took place in Lahore where a person attacked Hazrat Masih-e-Maoud (as) which caused him to fall down. So we faced constant opposition from common Muslims and we listened to their swearing and foul language. Instead of being angry at them we should pray for them and try and make them understand the reality. Finally in the end, it is amongst these people that the Promised Messiah (as) will be accepted. That day will definitely come when reality will be clear to them, that

Ahmadi Muslims are not the ones who tend to insult the Holy Prophet (pbuh). In fact, they are the ones who serve him best.

Hazrat Musleh Maoud (ra) has also relayed a saying of a person with regards to this, stating, “It is possible that you deceive some people but it is not possible that you can deceive the whole world”. This is what is happening today, that our opponents are filling other people’s hearts with opposition against us. In fact, this will only be beneficial for us. These people are spreading the message of Ahmadiyyat to places where we could not have reached. In the end it will be amongst these people that some will come forward and accept Ahmadiyyat. So our job is to always keep good and pious feelings towards Muslims and to pray for them, that Allah may enable them to accept the Promised Messiah (as) as soon as possible. Ameen.
