

Summary Friday Sermon 13 August 2021

Delivered by Hazrat Khalifatul Masih Al-Khamis (a.b.a.)

After Tashahhud, Ta'awwaz and the recitation of Surah Al-Fatehah, Huzur-e-Anwar said:

Alhamdulillah, Jalsa Salana UK ended last week with all its spiritual atmosphere and views. The administration was not completely prepared for it as they were thinking that the Jalsa will not take place this year. However, when they were told the Jalsa will take place, they worked very hard and the volunteers presented themselves with enthusiasm to take part in the duties. Normally the week after the Jalsa, I [Huzur-e-Anwar] thank all the volunteers who have worked for the Jalsa Salana, including men and women, boys and girls.

Hazrat Khalifatul Masih (aba) spoke of the people who are volunteers and especially who are given duty in the parking area. He spoke of the volunteers who worked in the rain and literally picked up cars out of the mud that was caused by the rain and set them to the side. Similarly Huzur-e-Anwar also spoke of MTA, the cleaning team and the set-up departments and gave special thanks to them.

Huzur-e-Anwar said that, since Jalsa Salana was of a much smaller scale this year there were very few volunteers used for duty this year, because of which many people were very sad that they did not get a chance to serve the Jamaat during the Jalsa. I would say to those people that Allah looks at your intentions. It was your intention to serve the guests of Hazrat Masih-e-Maoud (as). Allah Almighty will bless you for your true intentions. Huzur-e-Anwar said that a special attribute of this Jalsa that differed from all other Jalsa's was that aside from the participants who attended, there were members of the Jamaat from all over the world amounting to about 37 different places, including the UK, Australia, Bangladesh, Canada, America, etc.

Later on Huzur-e-Anwar spoke of the impressions of different non-Jamaat members who attended the Jalsa Salana. He said that people from all around the world are getting closer to Islam and Ahmadiyyat through these Jalsa's. May Allah grant us the fruits of Jalsa Salana and may he divert the pure souls towards the Jamaat.
