GENERAL INFORMRATION

Invitation

Registration

Access to Jalsa Salana Area:

- 1. A valid AIMS card is mandatory for entry into Jalsa Salana venue.
- 2. Members without an AIMS number or card must bring a verification letter issued and duly signed by local Sadr Sahib Jama'at

Important Note:

AIMS card must be displayed prominently during Jalsa Salana and upon entry to Jalsa Salana Area or Nasir Moskén

Transportation

Transportation for guests will be arranged for those who arrive to Göteborg by bus/train/flight.

Transportation is arranged between the Jalsa and accommodations(arranged by Jamaat), CentralStationen or Landvetter Airport

Everyone who needs Transportation while arriving to Göteborg must inform Local President. Its important that Transportation team gets the proper booking info so they can plan accordingly

Bus / Train - Pick up

You will arrive at Nils Ericsson Terminalen / Göteborgs Central Station. Meeting point at platform 15 (TrainStation)

Landvetter Airport

You will arrive at Landvetter Airport.

Transportation team will pick you up at arrivals.

A member will hold a sign at the arrival area for pickup

Transportation during the Jalsa


Transportation during or after the Jalsa should be booked at the Information desk which is directly after the entry.


Arriving own car

- Please follow the instructions of duty officers

Accommodation

If you need accommodation for your stay during the Jalsa Salana you should inform your local President to make an booking.

Name and mobile nr of the head of the family is needed and how many people the family consists of.

All guests who want to stay under jamaats arrangements should bring bed textiles (quilt- & pillow covers,pillow, bed sheet) and towels with them. Note! Exemption will only be made to those who arrive by flight.

Milk for Infants:

Milk for infants will be provided under the supervision of Nazima-e-Aala (Ladies Section).

MISCELLANEOUS GUIDELINES

First Aid/Medical Facilities:

During "Hospitality Period", volunteer doctors will be available during the Jalsa Days. Medical treatment for minor ailments will be provided free of charge. If, however, hospital care is needed, guests will be required to contact hospital or A&E as per individual condition.

Amanat, Lost & Found Property:

If anyone finds or loses belongings, please report to the Jalsa Office.

Pedestrian Movement outside Nasir Moskén:

Roads/streets outside Nasir Mosken are usually busy. Guests are advised to drive carefully and be watchful going on foot. When walking please respect traffic rules.

Cleanliness:

Please help us keep Nasir Mosque, just clean. Dustbins bins are placed at different places points for this purpose. Ensure minors implement practices.

JALSA GAH ETIQUETTES

- ✓ Remember the true purpose of Jalsa Salana is to strengthen our bond with Allah and increase in religious knowledge and brotherhood.
- ✓ Spend your time in remembrance of Allah by reciting Durood Sharif, Istaghfar, and Dua.
- ✓ Listen to the program in prayerful silence, keeping your heads covered with topi in respect of the occasion.
- ✓ Following the sunnah of our Holy Prophet (SAW), greet everyone with "Assalamo Alaikum" and a smile whether you know them or not.
 - ✓ Show consideration for each other.



SALAT ETIQUETTES

- ✓ The most important act performed as a community of faithful is congregational Salat. When the Adhan is called, begin to make the rows for prayer, filling the first row first.
- ✓ Keep Salat lines straight, without gaps—place shoes on the racks outside prayer halls and stand shoulder to shoulder in prayer halls.
 - ✓ Begin a new row for Salat only when the one in front of you is full.
- ✓ Do not place bags or children between worshippers, place them in front of you.
- ✓ After finishing your Salat, refrain from speaking until everyone has finished Salat.
 - ✓ Dress modestly and properly



CHAIR ETIQUETTES

- ✓ Only the elderly and those with physical disabilities should be seated on chairs.
 - ✓ Fill the first rows first.
 - ✓ Children and young kids should not be on the chairs.
 - ✓ Children and youth accompanying elderly please sit on the carpet area.
- ✓ At Salat time, move forward and fill all empty chairs to sit shoulder to shoulder.
- ✓ Do not leave your bags on chairs if you go to the floor to offer Salat. Take them with you or place on the floor so that others may use the chairs for Salat.
