May Allah Ta'ala show His Mercy upon us, amin. The best way to come under the Grace of Allah is to follow the guidance of our dear beloved Khalif, His Holiness Mirza Masroor Ahmad (aa), may all Ahmadi Muslims have the opportunity to do so.

Dear beloved Huzoor e Anwar (aa) has instructed us all to pray for the world, for the Muslims and for the Ahmadis.

For us Ahmadis, dear beloved Huzoor e Anwar (aa) has specially instructed us to get closer to our creator, Allah Ta'ala, the Gracious the Merciful. We can do this by saying the prayers our dear beloved Huzoor e Anwar (aa) has instructed us to do, which the Jama'at has conveyed to the members on several occasions.

Apart from prayers, which are the first and most important thing, it is also important that we follow the instruction of our dear beloved Huzoor e Anwar (aa) to collect necessary supplies in our homes, which should last for three months.

In each region, a group has been created that will lead the Jama'at's efforts in case of a possible disaster, this group will be led by the region's Sadr sahib.

All members of the Jama'at will be called to a meeting where we will go over how to act in the event of a disaster, but there are certain things I wish you to do right now.

1. Buy the necessary goods you need as soon as possible, don't wait! (see list of suggestions on our webpage)
2. Buy a tent (preferably with tent poles), everyone in the family should be able to set up the tent, please practice this so that all family members learn this. Remember that the tent must be large enough to sleep in and be able to fit all your packaging.
3. Buy sleeping bags.
4. For each family member, you should have ready a backpack containing clothes (at least 3 changes per person) as well as personal hygiene items, and any medicine.
5. Buy a first aid kit.
6. All family members should know the walking route home from work or school, as well as the walking route from home to the mosque/mission house.
